Board Review of 2023 Estimate Budget Worksheet/Spreadsheet (MaryKay)

It included expenses and income for years 2017-2022 and a <u>draft proposed estimate</u> <u>column</u> for the 2023 budget with expenses and income. The estimated expenses and income for 2023 has a blue background on the spreadsheet.

Discussion about the 2023 estimate budget included:

- The numbers in the proposed estimated budget for 2023 can change with income from donations and/or expenses for garden supplies.
- The membership list should be reviewed, it will be shared with Neil and Joan to update.
- Decision was made to use this spreadsheet/worksheet as the tool to document expenses and income.
- Possible investment of a portion of checking account funds into Money Market Savings/CDś
- We will look into different banks for interest rates and rules to invest.
- Further discussion at the next meeting.
- The Draft 2023 Estimate Budget worksheet was approved, noting it is a draft subject to change.

Major donation (\$500) from the SSCEF, the non-profit arm of the FR&GC. Letter will be sent to members in February. Accomplishments will be included in the letter.

<u>Updates:</u>

• Osprey Nest Cam: is up and running with sound

- <u>Visitor Center / Martin Road House (next steps)</u>: There are 3 sets of notes from the meeting. Glenn will send a summary to all the attendees and those that were not able to attend. MaryKay shared a draft proposal for the greenhouse. Discussion included: uses for the greenhouse, 2 week construction, stability of greenhouse, sketch of location on property, liability and MOU. Tom Eagle volunteered to use Google Earth for drawing of the location of the greenhouse on Martin Road property and said Refuge staff could assist with building and funding for the greenhouse. The Draft Proposal for Greenhouse will be updated and shared at a later date.
- <u>Achievements</u>: Glenn shared Achievements from 2022 document. List included: Osprey Cam, POH Camp with a new total of 500 Plants at Headquarters, Walk for the Wild, Pollinator Gardens (7), Revisited Mashpee Visitor Center, Girl Scouts, David Ross Palmer Award, Estuary Day, Newsletters. We added to the list: Featured in Refuge Highlights, Mentorship of AmeriCorp. Glenn will share the updated Accomplishments. The Accomplishments will be on the website and Facebook.
- <u>Newsletter:</u> Leo has completed his bio, Creature Feature and Eelgrass article. Nancy will send when completed. The Accomplishments will also be included. Leo shared the Osprey Cam project he is doing with 2 English Learning classes. They will learn about migration from Brazil, and life stages and behavior.
- <u>WFTW: (Walk For the Wild) Glenn mentioned that he sent the</u> application for 2023 and planning will begin in Spring and Summer.
